

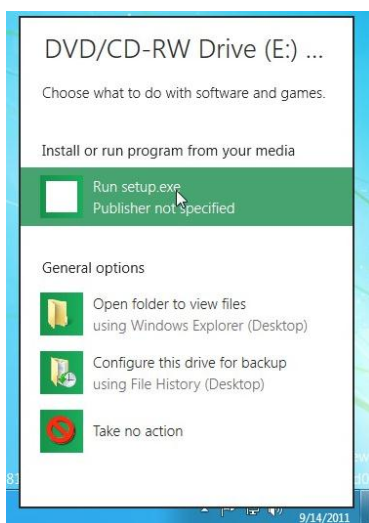

Install Microsoft Office

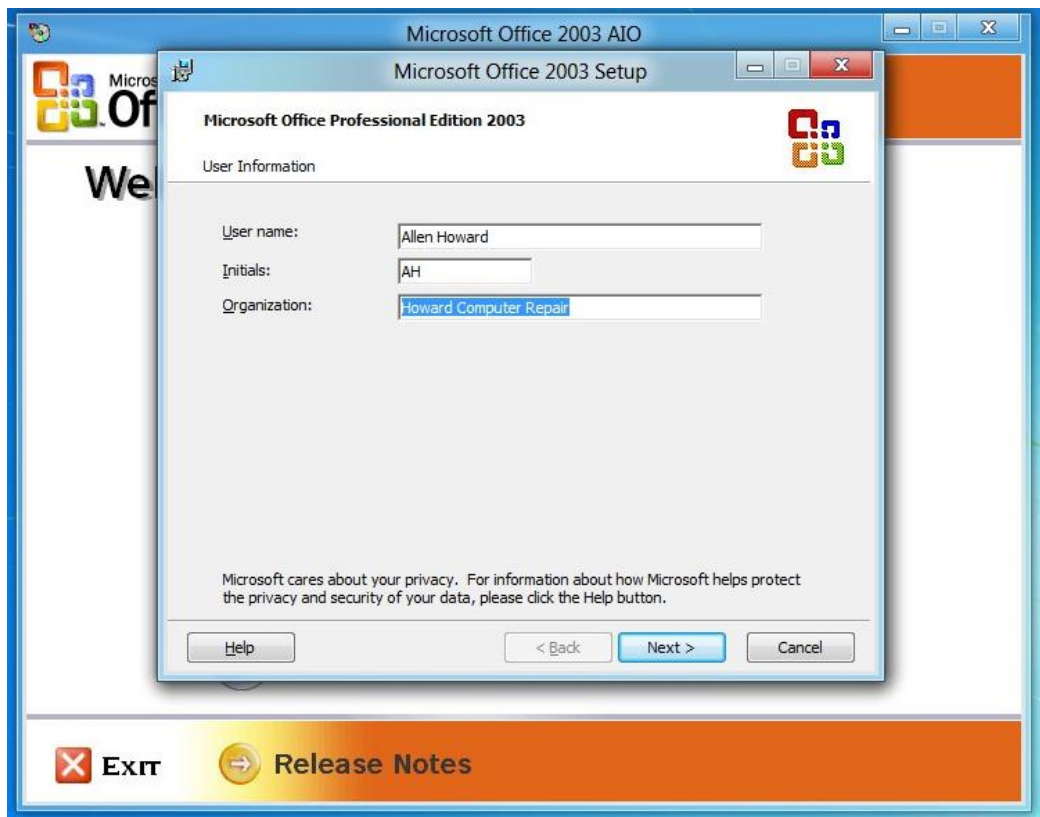
The first application I am going to install is Microsoft Office 2003. Although older, if it works, then Office 2007 and 2010 should also be able to work. First I inserted the Office 2003 install disc. Auto run options appear in the bottom right corner.



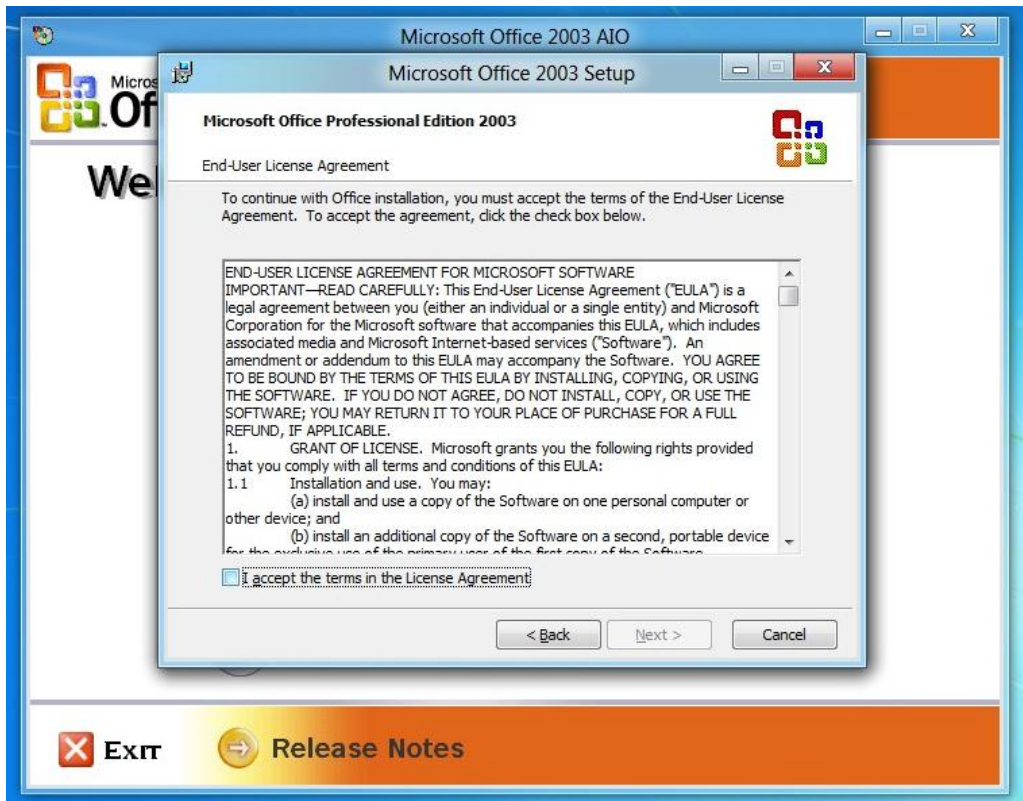
Click run Setup.exe



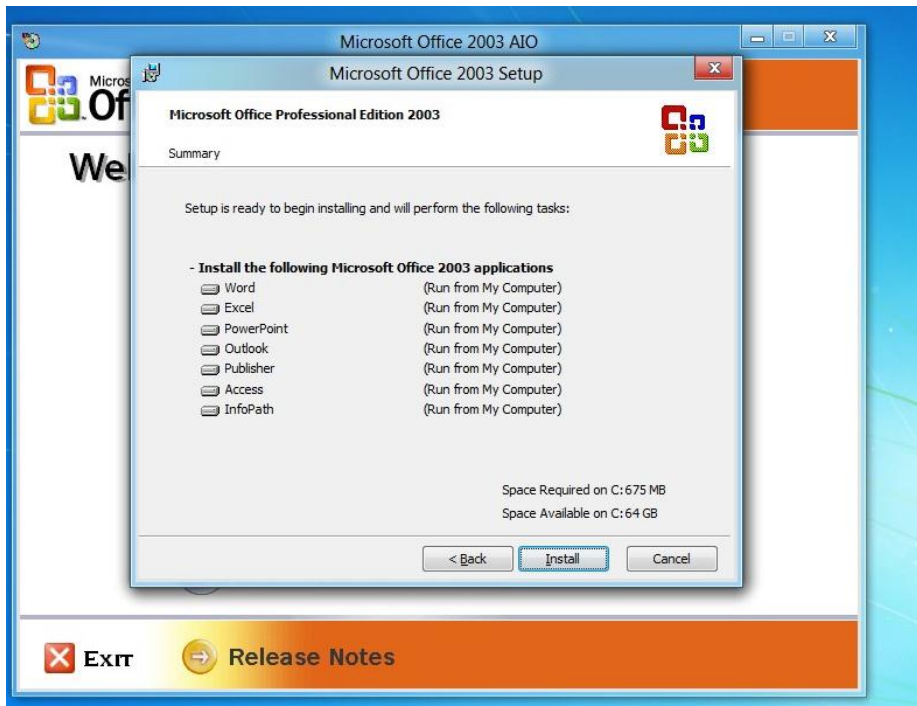
Allow the UAC Prompt. Now you will see the office installation wizard. Click Office 2003. Setup copies files and then prepares the wizard. Enter your product key and click next. Enter your User Name, Initials and Organization.



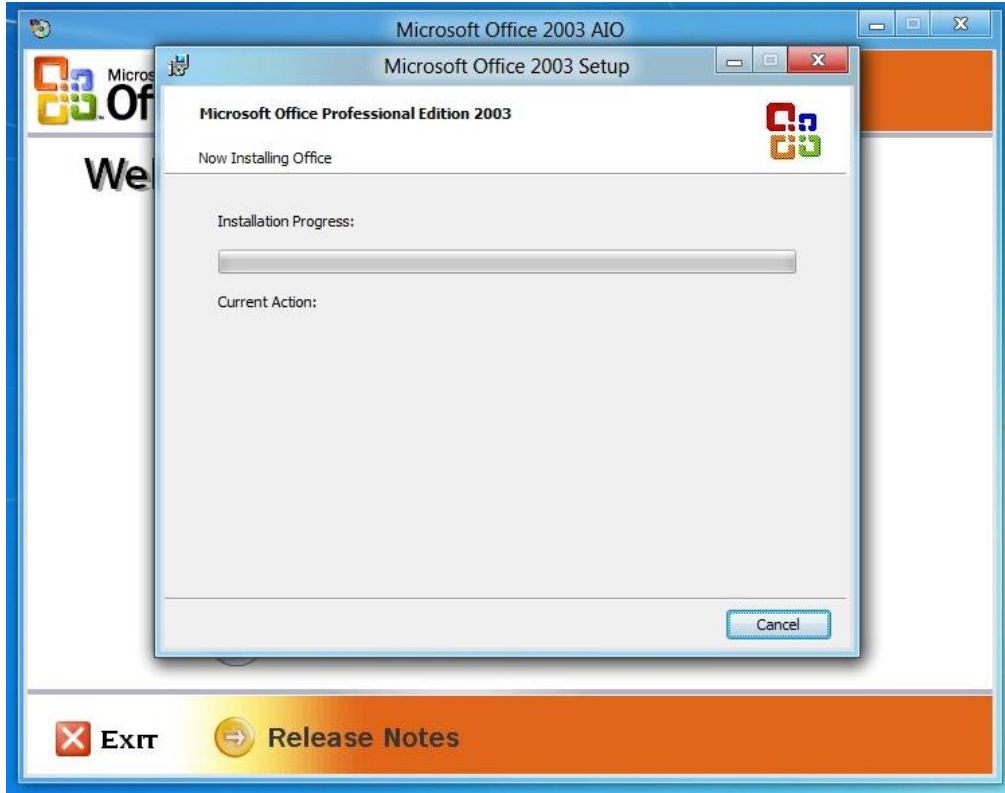
Agree to the license agreement.



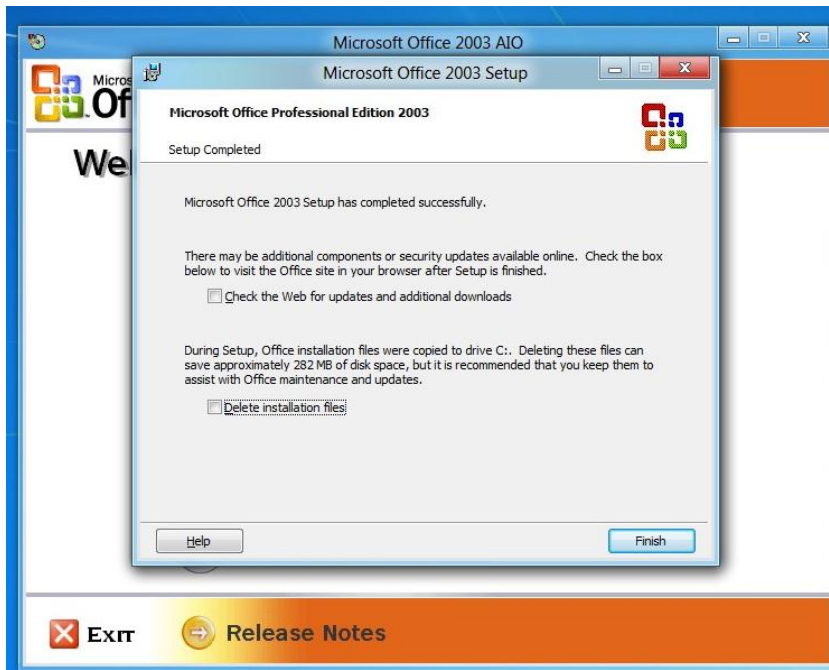
I am going to use the typical install settings. If you need to customize, go ahead and select what you need. Hit next when ready. Finally, click Install when you are ready.



It begins installing.

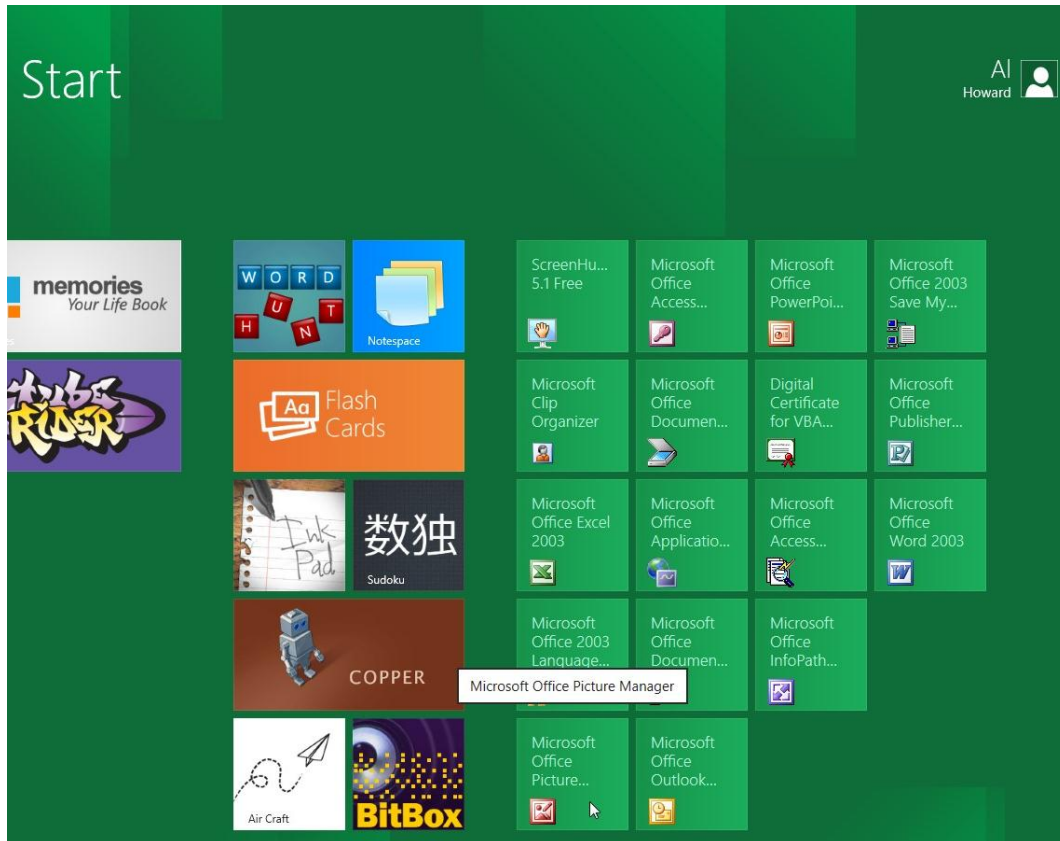


Select what you want to do and select Finish.

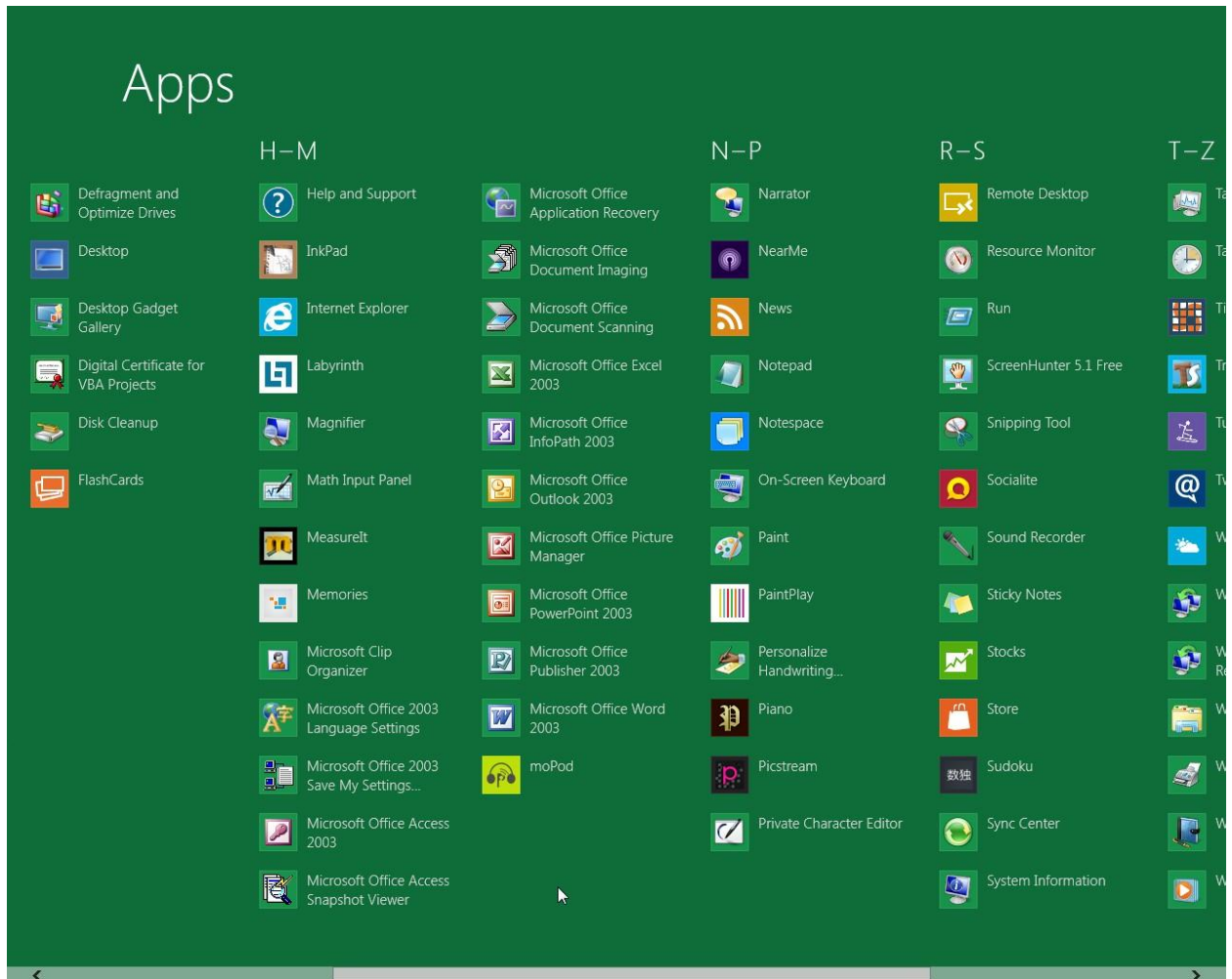


Finally, close the Office Window.

Now, there are two ways you can find the new office applications. Press the start button and scroll the whole way to the right and select which application you want to use or select search, click apps and find the M's. Office will be listed under there.
